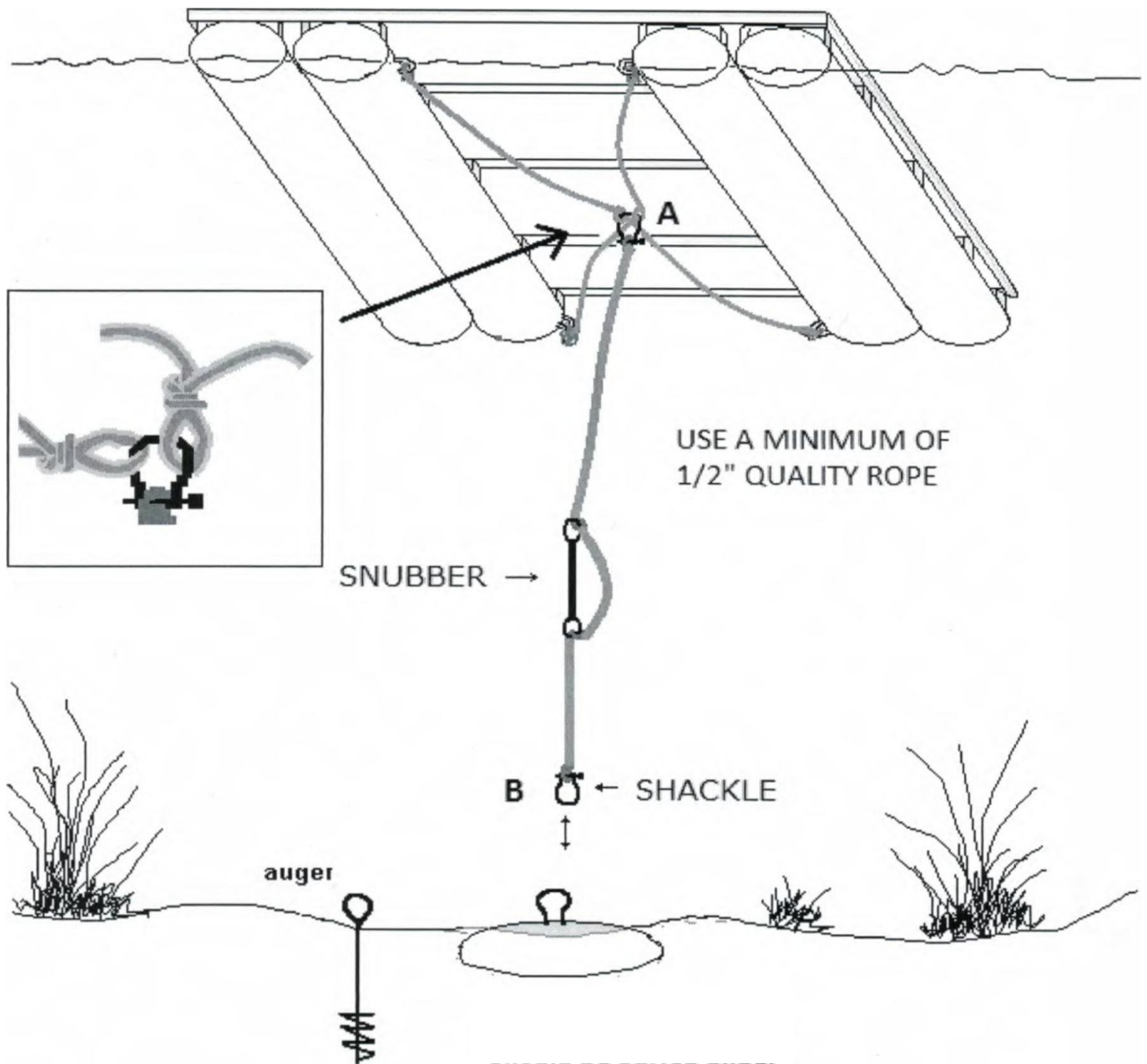


SWIM RAFT ANCHORING



Tops of anchor or auger should be buried under the lake bottom as much as possible

Use two pieces of rope, and in the middle of each piece tie an overhand loop knot. Tie the ends of the pieces of rope to the mooring eyes on the swim raft, crossing the pieces of rope to make an X. The two overhand loop knots should meet at the center of the "X". Attach shackle A to the two overhand loop knots. (During the winter the swim raft can be unattached at shackle A and a buoy attached in its place.) Attach another piece of rope to shackle A. In the middle of that piece of rope attach the snubber as shown above. At the opposite end of that piece of rope attach shackle B. Shackle B will attach to your anchor or auger.
